Convention registration deadline extended to April 1

There is now even more time to register for the NADD Chicago Convention! NADD has extended the registration deadline from March 16 to April 1.

With the current economic uncertainty, it was decided that the March 16 registration deadline might be limiting. So if you have been thinking about attending the Convention – but have held off because of time limits or finances – now is the time to register!

By extending the registration period by two weeks, you will not only have more time to plan, but you can also avoid the extra expense of a 'late fee.' Simply ignore that line on the registration form and save \$125.

The Convention features several outstanding speakers: Rev. James P. Steffes, Executive Director of the Secretariat for Clergy, Consecrated Life and Vocations, will address membership at the Awards Banquet about current activities within the USCCB. This is in addition to highly-anticipated keynote addresses from Bishop Octavio Cisneros, Rev. Thomas Baima and Dr. Samuel Betances; the Directors' Workshop with Rev. John Kaserow; and the Women's Workshop with Sr. Marcia Vinje.

We also have a quality lineup of facilitators planned for the Saturday morning Interest Sessions. Deacon George Neuman from the Diocese of St. Catharines, Ontario will facilitate the "What do we do about mentoring?" session. Deacon Gerald DuPont from the Diocese of Galveston – Houston will facilitate "The Deacon as Parish Life Coordinator (C. 517.2)." And Deacon Tom Lang from the Diocese of Dubuque will facilitate "The Coordinator of Pastoral Field Education" session.
