















Total Number of Permanent Deacons by World Region, 1970-2015


Total Number of Permanent Deacons in the U.S., 1971-2022








Distribution of Permanent Deacons by Ministry Status








Number of Active and All Permanent Deacons


Number of Ordinations to Permanent Diaconate








Number of Candidates to Permanent Diaconate








Age of Candidates to Permanent Diaconate








Age at Different Phases of Deacon's Life by Ordination Cohort







Number of Years Deacons (Intend to) Stay in Ministry by Year of Ordination








Percentage of Active Deacons Who Were Financially Compensated for Their Ministry








Distribution of Permanent Deacons Who Were Lost Each Year








Marital Status of Active Permanent Deacons






Marital Status of Active Permanent Deacons






Race and Ethnicity of Active Permanent Deacons

Summary of Main Takeaways

Trends Affecting the Number of Deacons:

- The total number of deacons grew from 58 in 1971 to 18,291 in 2018.
- The total number of deacons decreased by <1% between 2015 and 2022.
- The number of active deacons decreased by 6.5% between 2015 and 2022.
- The number of diaconal ordinations is fluctuating (420-702 a year).
- The number of candidates to diaconate decreased by 35% from 2019-2020 and 2022-2023.
- Candidates to diaconate are getting older.
- Newly ordained deacons are serving (or planning to serve) fewer years.
- The number of deacons lost each year is growing and the main reasons for those loses are deaths and retirements.

Trends in Selected Characteristics of Deacons:

- The marital composition of active deacons between 2005 and 2022 remained stable.
- Deacons are becoming more racially/ethnically diverse. The share of Hispanics increased by 4pp between 2005 and 2022.
- Deacons are becoming more educated. The share of deacons with B.A. or more grew by 9pp between 2005 and 2022.
